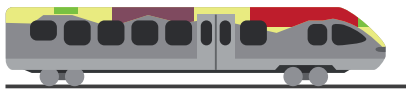


10 TIPS FOR CAREFREE HOLIDAYS

VISITING MERANO

By car or bus: Ideally at the following times: 8 – 10 am, 2 – 4 pm, or after 6 pm. Other times often experience a higher traffic volume and public transport is overcrowded.

Friday Market: A very popular market during which traffic is restricted due to blocked roads and high visitor numbers. **Our tip!** Get an early start: the best time to arrive is before 9 am.

Take your bike on board the train:
7 Euro per bike/day.
